(d.b.a., The Center) is one of the largest and most vibrant LGBT community centers in the nation. Functioning as the San Diego LGBT community's anchor organization, The Center is led by a 11-member board of directors, employs more than 70 paid staff and utilizes more than 1,200 community volunteers to achieve its twin goals of promoting LGBT health/wellness and human rights. The Center provides targeted programs and services to the full diversity of the San Diego LGBT community, including men, women, youth, seniors, transgender and non-binary individuals, families, LGBT Latin@ community members and their families, and those living with HIV. Last year, The Center provided more than 84,600 direct service visits to San Diego community members, and through its events, activities and advocacy, touched the lives of thousands more.

A MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD CO-CHAIRS

As Co-Chairs of The San Diego LGBT Community Center's Board of Directors, we want to thank you for your involvement, support, and advocacy. This past year has seen many milestones and phenomenal moments of growth.

We've been extremely proud of the tremendous leadership and cutting-edge work that our Center did this past year, when our community needed it the most. We provided life-sustaining humanitarian relief to LGBTQ asylum seekers and their families at the border, opened the South Bay Youth Center, stood with our transgender and nonbinary community, and expanded housing opportunities for those most vulnerable who are experiencing homelessness.

We've also increased our budget by a million dollars annually, our service visits to more than 84,600 annually, and our staff stands at 70. As we continue to grow, we want to do so intentionally, strategically, and thoughtfully.

Throughout our history, our community has strengthened The Center by its desires and demands for what the organization can, should, and will be. This moment is no different. We do our best not only to listen, but to respond. That is the reason that our CEO Caroline (Cara) Dessert and our Board of Directors decided it was an important time to engage in a strategic planning process.

The Center is embarking in a comprehensive strategic planning process to help guide it into the future. We have invited and involved the community in this effort with surveys, town halls, and stakeholder interviews.

A MESSAGE FROM THE CEO



Gratitude, Excitement, and Commitment

It's incredible to believe it has been a year since I received one of the most incredible honors of my life, to have been chosen to serve as The Center's CEO.

We have accomplished a lot over this past year at The Center and, with the community's support, have helped create a year of incredible opportunities and growth.

We opened our newest service location, the South Bay Youth Center. It's clear from the overwhelming response we've received from the community that we are making a difference in the lives of youth and their families in the South County, doubling our service numbers month over month.

We have expanded our housing opportunities for those experiencing homelessness, tripling the number of people we can shelter every night. We have a host home program, emergency housing programs, including a hotel voucher program and a four-bed shelter three nights per week. The Center is the first organization to offer an LGBTQ-focused emergency overnight housing program and host home program in San Diego County. Additionally, we implemented a family reunification program for LGBTQ youth experiencing housing instability or homelessness.

We embarked on the first LGBTQ border campaign in history, partnering with RAICES, Al Otra Lado Border Rights Project, and the Los Angeles LGBT Center to ensure that legal services, case management, and humanitarian relief to LGBTQ and asylum seekers living with HIV were provided to those who made it to the Mexican/U.S. border. None of our agencies had ever done a cross-border campaign like this before, but we all knew the need was critical, we had the courage to try, and we were all committed to working together.

It's not just immigrants, but also our transgender and nonbinary community that have been relentlessly attacked this year by the current Administration. At every turn, when these community members have been attacked, The Center has responded in a way that supports and develops long-term leadership and capacity in the transgender and nonbinary community.

While The Center has continued its vital work, we are also in a period of tremendous growth. We are providing more service visits than ever before, we've increased our budget by a million dollars annually, and the staff has grown to more than 70. This remains a time of organizational transition and, to that end, we have been engaged in a strategic planning process with significant community engagement to create the future that reflects the community we serve.

As we face real and unexpected challenges, we continue to respond with compassion and the highest levels of service. On behalf of all of us at The Center, I thank you for the incredible support of this community that makes all of this possible. We will take the support and trust you've placed in us and continue building upon our legacy of service and commitment to a San Diego where LGBTQ people and our families are connected, healthy, and thriving.

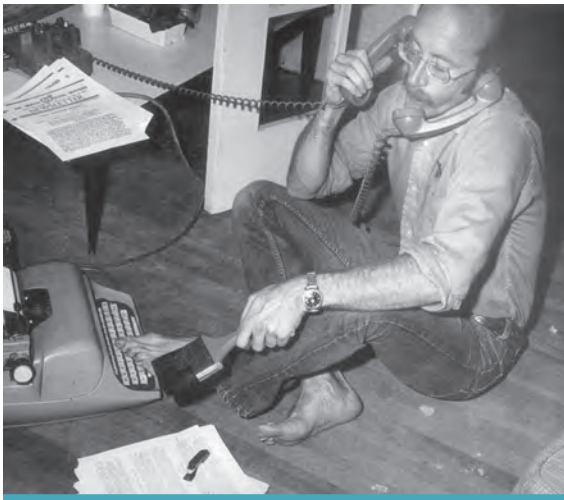

Originally just an answering machine in a borrowed closet that served as a lifeline for those looking for compassionate connection, it is now one of the largest and most vibrant LGBTQ Community Centers in the nation, providing our community with more than 84,600 direct service visits each year.

1973 The Center for Social Services was incorporated as a 501c3



1980 The Center for Social Services became the Lesbian and Gay Men’s Community Center

1981

Diagnosis of the first case of HIV disease in San Diego County

1998

The Behavioral Health Services RVTIP program received credentialing, and became one of the first same-sex domestic violence programs in the nation



1999

The Lesbian and Gay Men’s Community Center moved from Normal Street to Centre Street and began plans for renovations



2000

The Hillcrest Youth Center opened its doors and became a critical resource for LGBTQ youth in San Diego

2001

Dr. Delores A. Jacobs named interim executive director June 2001 and is selected as executive director in January 2002. Jacobs serves a historic, 17-year tenure as the longest serving chief executive, and retiring on June 30, 2018

The David Bohnett Cyber Center opened

2001

The Public Policy department was established after the No on Prop. 22 campaign



2002

The Lesbian and Gay Men’s Center was renamed The San Diego Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender Community Center

2003

The Women's Resource Center was established, providing LBT women and their allies access to important health and social resources and referrals

2003

AIDS Walk & Run San Diego returned to The Center as a Center program



2003 Senior Services and 50 and Better Together were established, providing important health, financial and social resources for LGBTQ seniors

2004

The Community Leadership Council was established, bringing together more than 40 LGBTQ and allied community organizations each month to address the needs of the community



2004

Latin@ Services was established, providing a culturally-affirming drop-in space, support groups, and social programs for LGBTQ Latin@s and their families



2004

The Wall of Honor was established, honoring community members and allies who have had a significant positive impact on the San Diego LGBTQ community



2006

Sunburst Youth Housing Project opened, providing supportive housing for 23 homeless LGBTQ and HIV+ youth, ages 18-24

2007

The Center Advocacy Project was established, a nonpartisan 501(c)4, whose mission is to secure equal civil and human rights for the LGBTQ and allied communities through public education and issue advocacy



2007

Family programming was re-established at The Center, providing programs and services for LGBTQ-headed families and those considering parenthood



2008

The Equality Voters program was established to encourage community-wide voter registration and full, non-partisan, participation in elections

2009

Nicole Murray Ramirez, Robert Gleason, Dr. Delores Jacobs, The San Diego LGBT Community Center, and a broad coalition of civic and business leaders established the first Harvey Milk Diversity Breakfast. Since then it has grown to become one of the largest, most diverse events of its kind, bringing together more than 1,000 San Diegans annually

2010

Engage San Diego was established, forming a nonprofit network of local civil rights, social justice, health and environmental organizations focused on nonpartisan civic engagement



2010

The Center became a monthly distribution site for the San Diego Food Bank

2011

Senior Housing Needs Assessment completed



2012

The Young Professionals Council was established in **2009** to develop and empower young LGBTQ professionals and their allies. As part of that effort, in **2012** the YPC Academy was established to help prepare young leaders to further equality through board service for a variety of agencies, not-for-profit organizations and government commissions

2012

The Benjamin F. Dillingham, III and Bridget Wilson LGBTQ Veterans Wall of Honor, first envisioned by Nicole Murray-Ramirez, was established in 2012 to honor and celebrate LGBTQ veterans who have served

2012

The Center began working with Community Housing Works to establish an LGBTQ-welcoming affordable senior housing project in San Diego



2013

Project TRANS was established to provide services designed specifically for San Diego's transgender, nonbinary, and gender nonconforming community



2014

The #BeTheGeneration campaign launched, with the goal of ending new cases of HIV within a decade



2016 The #BeTheGeneration TRANS campaign launched



2016 Construction begins on The North Park Senior Apartments, an affordable LGBTQ-welcoming housing project

2017

The Center's Youth Services opened the South Bay Clubhouse, a weekly drop-in space for LGBTQ youth in Chula Vista

2017

At The Center's 45th Anniversary Gala, a \$2 million dollar matching campaign opportunity was announced



2017

Dr. Delores Jacobs announced her intended retirement from The Center. Through more than 200 interviews and focus groups, feedback was solicited regarding characteristics sought in the new Center chief executive, led by Board Co-Chair Joyce Rowland



2018 The LGBTQ-welcoming affordable senior housing project opens



2018

The Center Board announces selection of Caroline (Cara) Dessert, Esq. as the next Center Chief Executive Officer effective July 1, 2018



2018

The Center reaches \$2 million goal with unprecedented community support, matching donors Ron Bowman, with his husband Stan Zukowsky announce a second gift of \$1.65 million to pay off mortgage for the Centre Street building in spring of 2018

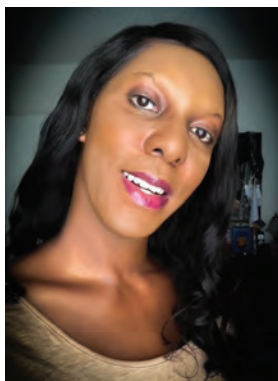
The Center added cutting-edge housing programs and services for LGBTQ folx experiencing homelessness, including a family reunification program, host home program, an emergency hotel voucher program, an overnight emergency housing program for LGBTQ youth that is currently open three nights a week, and we've doubled our permanent supportive housing program to include housing for LGBTQ adults, couples, and families. This expansion of The Center's housing services has been incredibly effective! We have been able to support more than **150 people with housing services and resources**



#BETHEGENERATION STORIES

The Center offers the **Determine Rapid HIV-1/2 Ab-Ag** test for the simultaneous detection of the HIV-1 p24 antigen as well as antibodies to both HIV-1 and HIV-2. Detection of the HIV-1 antigen permits earlier detection of HIV-1 infection (two to four weeks) than is possible by testing for HIV-1 antibodies alone (up to twelve weeks.) Along with the Determine test, The Center also offers the **UCSD Early Test** research study. Enrollment in the Early Test study includes a specialized viral load test that can detect acute (very early stage) HIV infection as soon as one week after potential exposure. **Hepatitis C (HCV) Rapid Antibody** screening is also offered. Both scheduled and walk-in Rapid Testing is available Monday through Friday 9am to 8pm, and Saturday 10am to 3pm. Early Testing is available Monday through Friday only and appointments are preferred. **For more information, or to schedule an appointment, call 619.692.2077 x101 or visit www.thecentersd.org/programs/bethegeneration.**

In FY2019, we identified 12 individuals who were newly diagnosed with HIV. 83% of those newly diagnosed were linked to care. As of today, 92% of those linked to care successfully remain in care.



Pamuela

"I want to let people know that it is ok to like, enjoy, and have sex. I want to talk to people about having sex their way, using their boundaries so everyone feels respected, safe, healthy, and consensual. I also want to help dispel the myth that many members of the community may have by default that people who are living

with HIV will end up alone. There are plenty of wonderful, attractive people who have HIV and they do not end up alone."



Rick

"When I first learned about PrEP, I thought about getting on it, but I heard so many guys say "that's only for sluts" that I was afraid of the stigma and the way people might try to shame me if they knew I was on PrEP. Luckily, I eventually got past that and made the appointment with my doctor. I've now been on PrEP for over a year. Sure,

I got called a "slut" a couple of times, but I know that I am the one who has empowered myself to take care of my own health. Making the appointment to see my doctor about PrEP, and then deciding to start taking it, was one of the best decisions I've made in my entire life."



Boyd

"Before me, there were entire generations of men, women and children around the world whose lives slowly deteriorated due to HIV. There were

thousands of people who participated in research projects and gave themselves as test subjects to finding a cure. These efforts all culminated in the current state of affairs that allow people like me to live a fairly normal, symptom-free life and flourish. Until science finds, develops and provides a cure for HIV, the next best thing is for me, and those like me, who are living a long happy life, to continue to educate and enlighten others about this virus. Prevention through education is key."

New Housing Programs

Host Home Program

In late 2018, The Center added a Host Home program, which is the first and only LGBTQ-focused program of its kind in San Diego County. The Center identifies, screens, and trains community members who volunteer to house young people 18-24 in need of immediate, short-term housing in their homes, with the option of longer-term housing. **For more information, contact youth@thecentersd.org.**



Emergency Safe S.T.A.Y

40% of homeless youth are LGBTQ. In late 2018, in an effort to help address this crisis, The Center added San Diego

County's first LGBTQ-focused emergency overnight housing services for unhoused youth ages 18-24. In addition to providing hotel vouchers, the program offers beds three nights per week and connects participants to permanent housing and additional support services through youth systems navigation and case management services. **For more information, contact youth@thecentersd.org.**

Project Compassion

Project Compassion is The Center's first endeavor of direct outreach reaching folks that are experiencing homelessness.

South Bay Youth Center
