








Preventing Homelessness in San Diego County



Avoiding Homelessness

When The Braxtons reached out to The Center, they were in the process of eviction and facing the terrifying possibility of homelessness. With no way to pay their overdue rent and nowhere to turn, they needed our support.

The Braxtons and The Center's
Adult Housing Services team
worked together to create a plan
to keep them housed and find
stability, which included helping
them apply for assistance
programs, building a workable
budget, and working towards
increasing their household income.



Most critically, our team advocated on the Braxtons' behalf with their property manager, who had initially refused to negotiate. Through persistent and heartfelt communication, we were able to shift the conversation, and the property manager agreed to accept the overdue payments and halt the eviction process.

Since receiving services, the Braxtons remain in their home and continue to work towards their financial goals to support long-term stability.

More than just a story about avoiding eviction, this is a story of resilience, dignity, and a family who, when given the right support at the right time, reclaimed their future. For our team at The Center, walking alongside the Braxtons has been a profound reminder of why we do this work. Their courage and determination inspire us and affirm our belief that when people are given the help they need, their lives can be transformed.
